

## Emergency medics get an early present

Christmas has come early for a group of volunteer emergency medics.

Jess Wright Graphics, of Manywells, in Cullingworth, has played Santa by presenting the Worth Valley First Responders with two sets of purpose designed ambulance logos. These have been put together free of charge to identify the vehicles used by the team to respond to 999 calls in the area.

The high-visibility logos are reflective, so will inform other road users of the responders' urgent business during the day and night. They are also meant to help ambulance crews locate the patient's address.

James Lee, Worth Valley First Responders co-ordinator, said: "These new signs will be a great help when we are attending calls and I would like to thank Jess Wright on behalf of all our members for his generosity."

The group will be working over the Christmas holiday period, providing vital first aid to patients in the minutes before the ambulance arrives.
